No. 4. SIGNALLERS' CONTEST.

Team to consist of 9 working N.C.O.'s or men and 11 N.C.O.'s to supervise but not take part.

Message to be correct in preference to shortest time taken in sending. Message to be written down in correct manner on an "A" form.

METHOD OF SENDING MESSAGE Route.

Man to start from the Base equipped with Telephone, Earth-pins and Climbing irons.

Climb over obstacles as arranged by the Committee and, after clearing the last obstacle, runs certain distance to a pole, from the top of which a telegraph line has been run out. Climbs pole, connects up the terminals and speaks a message through phone. Receiver at the other end writes the message down and man with Morse key sends it on.

Receiver at the Distant station receives message from the flags and Writer-down calls to man with the Disc, who sends the message on. Receiver at Distant station calls to Telephonist, who writes down and Buzzes message along wire, which is laid before race commences.

Receiver at Distant station writes message down correctly, disconnects his telephone, picks up, mounts horse waiting for him, and after clearing certain hurdles as arranged, he gallops back to base and hands message back to Umpire.

MAN-HANDLING GUN.

Position at starting point: Guns dressed and Detachment Rear. The Nos. 1 will be handed orders for coming into action and the Umpire will order "Without dragropes prepare to advance," and he will immediately give the word "Go!" The detachment will advance at the double with the gun 50 yards to a line. The first team past the line will receive 3 points, second 2 points and third 1 point.

As soon as the gun passes the line Nos. 1 will give instructions as contained in orders. The first team to report "Ready," if correct, receives 3 points, second 2 points, third 1 point. Umpire will then order "Cease firing and Limber up." The points as above will be allotted to the first, second and third teams in forming Detachments Rear.
