

Instructions.

1. **Correspondence.**—All correspondence will be addressed to your Battery Commander. Add Rank and Regimental Number to your signature.

2. **Address.**—Any change of address must be notified in writing to your Battery Commander.

3. **Uniform.**—Where uniform has been issued it must be worn on all parades, but cannot be worn on other occasions without permission of your C.O. Attendance at parades in part uniform and part civilian dress will not be allowed.

Dress for daylight parades, unless otherwise ordered is Hat, Jacket, Breeches, Leggings, Boots, Spurs, and Bandolier.

4. **Clothing & Equipment, Text Books, Etc.**—Must be returned to Unit Headquarters before Transfer or Discharge can be granted, and also on application for Leave for a period of two or more months. Receipts on A.A.F. F.25 must be obtained for all articles returned.

5. **Efficiency.**—To become efficient, attendance at Commanding Officer's Parade shown on this card is necessary; or if Leave of Absence is granted; at the Privilege Parade specified by your Battery Commander.

6. **Promotion.**—Enquire at your Battery Headquarters for information regarding the qualifications necessary and dates of Special Instruction.

NOTICES.

1. Enlistment in the Military Forces entails serious obligations under the Defence Act and these obligations continue, unless the soldier is sooner lawfully discharged, dismissed or removed, until the expiration of his engagement.

2. Absence without leave from a Commanding Officer's parade, or from a camp of continuous training, is a serious offence involving liability to a fine which is recoverable in a civil court.

3. Commanding Officers Parades are clearly indicated on this parade card. Leave of Absence from any such parade may be obtained for sufficient reason but, except in the case of sudden illness (which should be reported as soon as possible), prior application is necessary, preferably in writing.

In the event of your being unable to attend any of the above ordered parades, you will, previously to the date set out for the parade, apply to your Bty. Commander in writing, if possible, for leave of absence, and such leave may be granted for any reason which to him may appear sufficient. In granting leave of absence the officer so doing may specify an equivalent Additional Parade of equivalent duration which you are required to attend as if it had been specified as a C.O.'s. parade in this order.

4. Fares will be issued from Battery Offices from 1900 hrs.

5. Clothing and Equipment will be issued by R.Q.M.S. between 1900 hrs. and 1930 hrs.

6. Voluntary Rides will be held as per horse allotment.
