
I am enthused by the standard of performance of all members of "The Regiment", our morale, positive attitudes and will to do well and true pride.

 Whats the difference between an elephant & an Italian widow?..... Oh about 20lbs & a black dress!


I went away one time

IN JULY 1900, AT A SMALL OUTPOST IN SOUTH AFRICA CALLED ELAND'S RIVER A BAND OF MEN, AUSTRALIANS, ALL VOLUNTEERS, ALL CITIZEN SOLDIERS STOOD AGAINST OVERWHELMING ODDS FOR SIX HOURS THEN PACKED IT IN BECAUSE SIX HOURS CONSTITUTES ONE FULL WORKING DAY.
