WHAT a shameful picture emerges from the leaked MoD report about the preparedness of British soldiers spearheading Nato's advance into Kosovo last June.




Fortunately, the Army's mission was to shepherd the Serbs out of Kosovo, not expel them forcibly. Imagine the casualties that might have been sustained had things



### Soldiers' weapon training 'poor'

LACK of discipline and poor weapons training are being blamed for a dangerously high number of accidental rifle discharges by Australian soldiers in East Timor.

According to some sources up to 50 so-called unauthorised discharges (UDs) have occurred since Australian troops arrived in late September.

Defence officials refused to discuss the extent of UDs, claiming that the number of accidental discharges in an operational area was confidential due to "operational security".

A defence spokesman would not confirm or deny reports that a senior officer had been docked a week's pay after he shot a round through the ceiling of his office.

He also would not be drawn on

claims that one round had been accidentally fired through the fuselage of a C130 Hercules transport aircraft.

The spokesman would not say whether or not any injuries had been sustained from the accidental discharges. However, one military source said the army was extremely worried about the figh rate.

"UDs are not acceptable and the penalties are very severe especially in an operational area," the source said.

The penalties include loss of pay, restricted duties and remedial weapons training.

A Government source said the high rate of UDs had nothing to do with the controversial Steyr rifle, but was entirely due to a lack of training and discipline.



### When I walk long distances I tend to get blisters on my feet. I have tried wearing different socks and different types of running shoes, but the problem keeps happening. Have you got any suggestions?

I know it may sound a little bizarre, but using an anti-perspirant on your feet before hiking may help reduce blisters. That's because blisters are often triggered by a combination of shoe friction and moisture from sweat. One particular group especially prone to this problem are army cadets who have to walk long distances in sweaty boots. For this reason, West Point cadets in the US were recently selected to be the guineapigs for a study into walking and blisters. For these troops, wearing a roll-on anti-perspirant containing aluminium on their feet daily for at least three days before a hike was the key to avoiding blisters. It remains to be seen whether this now means anti-perspirants will be included in the list of essential army rations! Wearing cotton socks and well-ventilated shoes could also help.
