RULES AND CONDITIONS

Runners and Riders' names to be given in to the Clerk of the Course on the Race course half an hour before starting time for each event.

Bell will be sounded 10 minutes before the time of starting each race and an additional warning 5 minutes before the starting of each race.

Horses late at the Starting Post will be disqualified for that race.

Horses taking part in a race to enter past spectators before proceeding to Starting Post.

Objections as to correct description and qualifications of horses to run, to be made to Clerk of Course half an hour before the time fixed for the race.

Objections as to qualifications of riders or the timing of the race to be lodged to Clerk of the Course before rider dismounts and within 5 minutes of horse passing the winning post.

A BLUE flag will be hoisted in the event of an objection being lodged.

A WHITE flag hoisted means O. K.

Only Bookmakers registered with the Club allowed to field.

No odds to be called outside special enclosure for Bookmakers.

Colors and saddle cloths will be drawn from Clerk of the Course before each race and are to be returned to him immediately after finish of each race.

Order of starting as per programme No. 1 being on the right.

In the Open Races all horses to carry a minimum weight of 11 stone.

All horses entering for any Race Meeting with in 7th Brigade must have name and description registered with 7th Brigade Jockey Club.

All horses must at all times race under their registered names.

A. J. C. Rules will apply to the actual running of all races.
