- (1) 3rd. Australian Divisional Artillery will relieve the Left Sector Artillery, 2nd. Anzac, in the line, on nights 17/18, 18/19, 19/20, instant.
- (2) The relief will be carried out according to programme attached.
- (3) One Section per Battery, 8th. F.A. Brigade will go into action after dark on the night 16/17, and will come under the command of the O. C. Left Group for tactical purposes. All arrangements to be made between O.C. Left Group and O.C. 8th. F.A. Brigade.
- (4) All arrangements for the relief will be made between O.S. C. Groups, and O.S. C. relieving Brigades.
- (5) Completion of the relief of each Section will be reported as follows:-

- (6) No equipment will be exchanged.
