SIGNAL COMPETITION FOR BATTERY SIGNALERS.

To be held in the Chateau grounds on Saturday, 25th May 1918.

3 PM

1. Each Battery will be represented by 6 Signallers, completing 2 stations of 3 men each.
2. Each station will be furnished with:-
 - (a) 1 Lucas Lamp complete.
 - (b) 1 do do stand.
 - (c) 1 message case filled with message forms.
 - (d) 1 blue flag, small.
 - (e) 1 white do do.
3. The competition will be visual communication, i.e. a message will be handed in at "A" station and sent to "B" by Lucas Lamp. "B" station will then send a message to "A" by flag (morse).
4. Judges will be the Commanding Officer, 7th Aust. Field Artillery Brigade, who will award points for discipline and general turnout, and Officer Commanding, 3rd Aust. Division Signals, who will award points for technical ability of men. The Officer Commanding, Signals, D.A. will award points for cleanliness and care of instruments.
