B.M. 8/6 - Addendum to C.O. No. 111 and giving Zero day and Hour. Zero Hour 5.45 a.m. The day broke misty and dull but by 9 a.m. the weather was bright and sunny. Both Infantry Brigades were reported across the Canal in 25 minutes and later, all objectives were gained. At 9.30 a.m. the C.O. went forward to reconnoitre. Enemy's artillery fire during the morning was light but increased later in the day and was mostly confined to forward areas. At 9 p.m. the Brigade came under orders of 25th Brigade R.F.A. 3rd D.A. N. 386 - Instructions re possible move forward. 3rd D.A. N. 390 - Location of 3rd D.A. 3rd D.A. C.O. No. 112 - Relief of 1st Inf. Bde and re-distribution of artillery covering the front.	App. 11. LA VALEE MULATRE		5th	The weather became wet again. Brigade again came under orders of 3rd Aust. Div. Army and received instructions to withdraw to Wagon Lines in LA VALEE MULATRE. All ammunition was returned to A.R.P. and the Battery positions were reported clear by 5 p.m. Headquarters moved to Billat at W.34.C.4.5. 3rd D.A. C.O. No. 113 and 7th Brigade T/9/85 - 7th Brigade to withdraw to Billats in MONTERECHAIN	App. 14.
