| <u>HAUTMONT.</u> | 14-1-1919 | | Weather continued fine. The D.A.C. held a Race Meeting at FERRIERE -la-GRANDE. Horses from this Brigade competed but were not successful in bringing away any of the prizes. | |
| | 15-1-1919 | | Another day of football. 25th played 107th Battery Rugby and this resulted in a win for 25th and which gave the latter the Premiership of the Brigade. The Aust. Rule match between 25th and 27th was won by 25th. | |
| | 16-1-1919 | | Semi-finals of the Aust. Rules Competition were commenced to-day with fine weather. 107th Battery played 27th Battery and the latter won. | |
| | 17-1-1919 | | A Race meeting was held by 25th Battery at the Fort D'Hautmont and proved a great success. | |
| | 18-1-1919 | | The second match of Aust. Rules semi-finals was played to-day between 25th and 107th Batteries and resulted in a victory for 25th. The winners of this match were to play 27th Battery for the Premiership. | |
| | 19-1-1919 | | Weather still continued fine. A combined Church Parade was held at the Cinema Hall and was an inspection held by the Corps Commander. | |
| | 20-1-1919 | | A Rugby match was played between 7th and 8th Brigades and after a very hard game the 8th won by 3 points to nil. | |
| | 21-1-1919 | | The Aust. Rules Premiership was decided to-day the 25th Battery gaining the victory. This made 25th Battery Premiers in both Aust. and Rugby Rules. | |
| | 22-1-1919 | | It was now decided to hold dances in the Brigade. A Hall was obtained in HAUTMONT and a committee appointed to arrange dates for several Battery Dances. | |
| | 23-1-1919 | | The 7th Brigade Mounted Sports Meeting which was to be held on two successive days, was commenced to-day and in spite of the frozen ground the day went off very well. | |
